THE ADVANCEMENT OF SCIENCE.
 Circulars are to hand giving particulars of the next meeting of the Australasian Association for the Advancement of Science, which will be held in Brisbane in January next. The president-elect is Professor W. H. Bragg, of the Adelaide University, and the presidents of the respective sections are—Astronomy, mathematics, and physics, Professor J. A. Pollock, Sydney University; chemistry, Professor Easterfield, University College, Wellington; geology, Professor E. W. Skeats, Melbourne University; biology, Mr. Charles Hedley, Australian Museum, Sydney; geography, Mr. A. H. S. Lucas, Sydney; ethnology and anthropology, Mr. Augustus G. Hamilton, curator Dominion Museum, Wellington; social and statistical science, Mr. G. H. Knibbs, Federal Statist; agriculture, Mr. H. W. Potts, principal Hawkesbury College, New South Wales; engineering and architecture, Professor R. W. Chapman, Adelaide University; sanitary science and hygiene, Dr. J. Mason, health officer, New Zealand; mental science and education, Mr. Peter Board, Under Secretary, Department Public Instruction, New South Wales. Evening popular lectures will be delivered by Dr. R. L. Jack, Professor P. Marshall, Dunedin, and Mr. J. H. Maiden, director Botanic Gardens, Sydney. Amongst the excursions contemplated are those to Caloundra, for marine biologists; to Toowoomba and the Darling Downs, for southern visitors; also to the neighborhood of Gladstone to enable members to visit the southern extremity of the Great Barrier Reef and the sub-tropical palm forests of the North Coast railway. The last meeting of the association in Brisbane was held in 1895, and was very successful. The Railway Departments of each of the Australasian States, as well as the leading shipping companies, have granted the usual concessions to members travelling to and from the meeting. The secretaries for South Australia are Mr. Walter Howchin and Dr. Madsen, of the Adelaide University.
