

in upper sixth form, passed higher public with general honours in five subjects out of five, with first credit in applied mathematics; won open Government medical bursary; won certificate of efficiency and good conduct every term except one while at college. 1915—Began first year medicine at University; top of first year with a first-class; won Elder prize.

The Elder prize is awarded under a bequest from Sir Thomas Elder for the most successful student in medicine each year. Mr. Rayner is the fifth student in medicine to secure the scholarship. Two law students, one arts, and five science have previously been selected.

The new Rhodes scholar's athletic feats have been equally meritorious. At football he graduated from the third eighteen at college to the first, of which he was captain in 1914, and he headed the goal-kicking list for three seasons, and won the Dr. Counter medal last year. In the season concluded last September, he played for University "A," and was recommended for his "blue." In that year he was finally a member of the Sturt team, which defeated Port Adelaide for the premiership. For three seasons he was captain of his cricket team at college, and won several prizes for fielding and general play. On entering the university he was chosen as a member of the "A" grade team. He is the most promising batsman in first-class cricket this season, his scores, so far, having been phenomenal. Many pedestrian prizes have fallen his way, and this year he is University champion at rowing, shooting, tennis, and swimming, and also in the gymnasium Mr. Rayner has been successful in numerous contests. He has also figured conspicuously in the citizen forces, and before he left college was promoted from the rank of sergeant to a lieutenant. For some years he was a prefect at Prince Alfred College, and leader of the Bible Study Circle in the College Christian Union. Latterly he has been teacher in the junior department of the Glenelg Congregational Sunday School, and Secretary of the University Christian Union.

ADELAIDE ESSAYS.

'Reflections on the War,' by Professor G. O. Henderson, M.A. (Oxford); Haesel and Son, Adelaide.—Professor Henderson's lectures on the war have been so warmly received, both in the city and in 30 country centres—incidentally making a handsome profit for the Belgian Relief Fund—that their presentation in some permanent form was a certainty. Their original purpose has to be remembered in reading them now. Conciseness, clearness, the reaching a full comprehension of a mixed audience—these were the main requisites. As essays, they barely do justice to the author's great intellect and polished style. He sacrificed something of himself to reach the public at which he aimed, and his end was fully accomplished. He is all too modest, however, when he remarks in the preface:—"I have said nothing that has not been said many a time." True, the first essay, on the Responsibility for the war, just serves up the familiar White Book evidence and admissions. It is the "scrap of paper" argument presented with clearness, and will be valuable to those who want the facts in handy form, as well as comforting to those who never tire of being assured that we are everything noble, the enemy everything vile. As a New York paper said just after war was declared, Sir Edward Grey "put all his cards upon the table face upwards! Germany presents a lawyer's brief, a special pleading."
