SCIENCE AND INDUSTRY

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S OFFER

FINANCIAL AID FOR RESEARCH

Melbourne, December 22.

An interesting announcement was made by the Prime Minister (Mr. Hughes) today at the farewell luncheon tendered him by the Professorial Board of the Melbourne University that the Federal Government were prepared to spend up to £500,000, if necessary, on the establishment and administration of an institution for the conduct of scientific research in its relation to industry. The statement was made in reply to a suggestion that a national laboratory be established in Australia.

Sir John Madden, Chancellor of the University, in proposing Mr. Hughes' health, said they wanted him to bring together representatives of the States and the Commonwealth in the formulation of a scheme.

Professor O'Boone, referring to the position in which Great Britain found herself since the war, owing to the scarcity of necessary pigments, said it was because they relied too much upon Germany for supplies, and because there had been no organised economical research in England to carry out effectively the project of a Federal institution that there would have to be liberal endowment.

Professor Cherry said that in the Universities of the six States, there was a great deal of machinery on hand.

Mr. Hughes, replying, said science should act as a beacon of industry and guide its feet through mazes of experiments. It had been shown what potential wealth there was in this country, but they were practically in their swaddling clothes economically. They were in their school days. He thought the idea of a national laboratory was the corner stone of the edifice. (Hear, hear.) They could gather round them men of all branches of science and utilise them in the opening up of new avenues for fresh industrial efforts. They could increase their productivity from 15 to 20 per cent., and that applied to a million of money would mean a splendid achievement. Whatever was done must be done on sound lines. There must be a combination of science and business capacity, and they must have the co-operation of the Universities in each State. The Commonwealth Government would endeavor to co-ordinate with the Universities in this direction. The Government would do all they could to make the project a success. (Cheers.) They were not committed to details. As far as possible they would avail themselves of the ability and services of scientific men in their own industries, but if it was necessary to strengthen the staff it would be reinforced from outside. He would make enquiries during his visit abroad, but in any case the Government without delay would take the necessary steps to give the institution a start. (Cheers.)

Professor Anderson Stuart (Sydney), suggested the appointment of a Commission to report on the scheme.

Mr. Hughes said he had lost faith in Commissions. No institution began better or ended worse. (Laughter.) He suggested that they should invite representatives of the Universities to meet in Melbourne at an early date to consider the whole question and make suggestions to further the ends of industry. The Government were prepared to give 20/ for every 20/ worth. The Government would give £5,000, £50,000, or £500,000, if necessary. He said deliberately that it was the best investment Australia could make, and if they gave £50,000 they would be getting every penny of their money back. (Cheers.)
