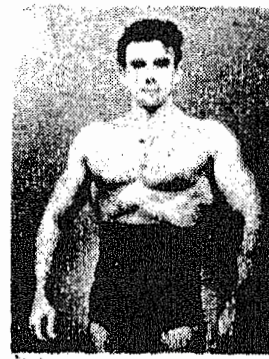

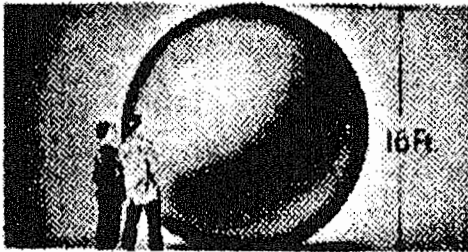
Do you like to play Squash?

1956. Directed by Albert Lamorisse. 34 minutes.

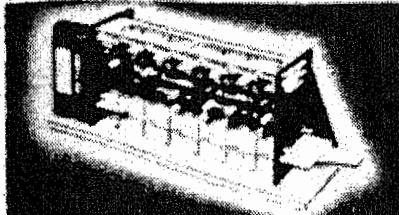

Division 6 Women White lost to Murray Bridge 6-0.

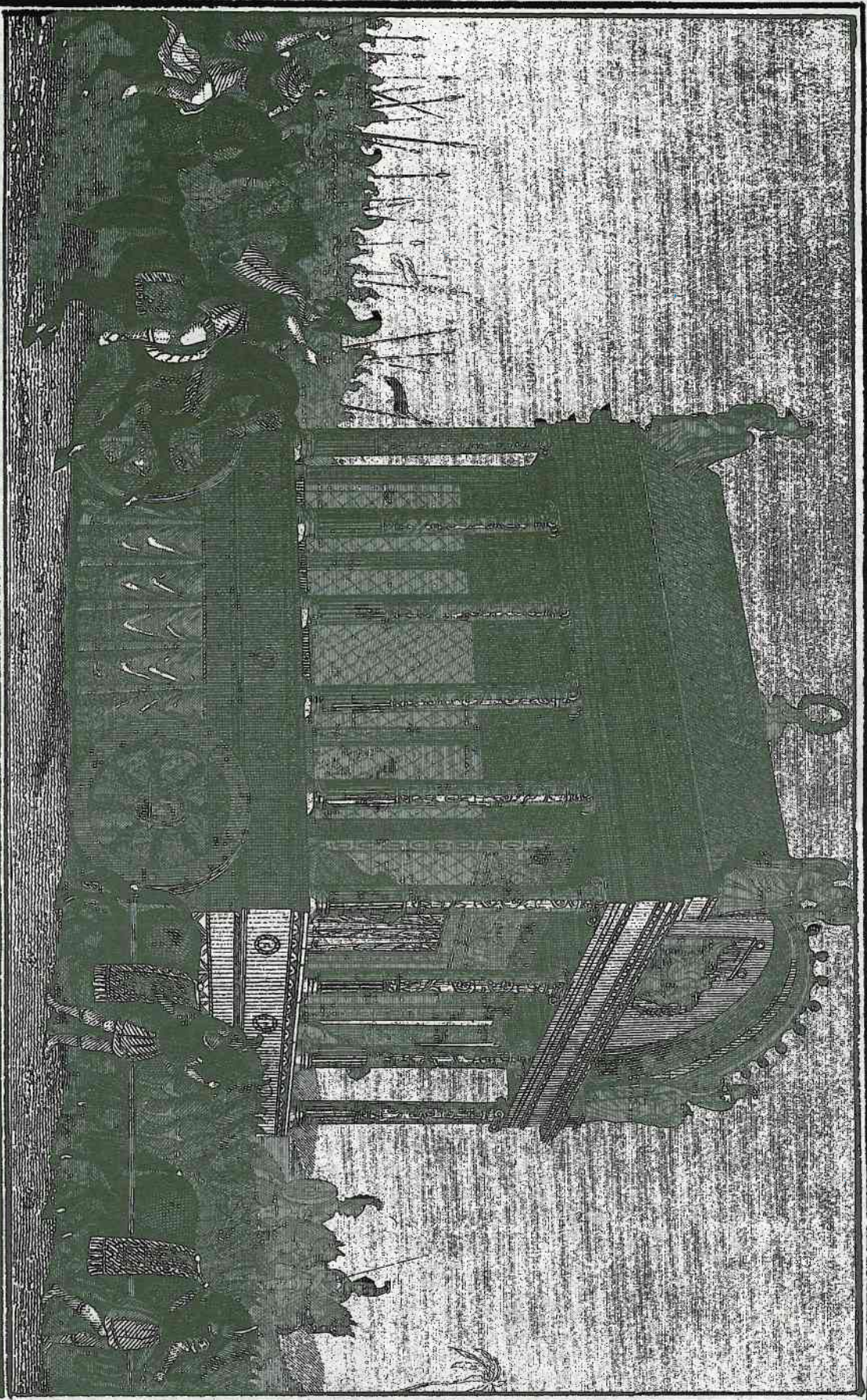
