**ELDER TRAVELLING SCHOLARSHIP.**

Miss Helena Fisher, the 16-years-old daughter of Mr. A. J. Fisher, of Largs Bay, has crowned a series of unique achievements in the realm of music by winning the Elder Travelling Scholarship. She is the youngest student who has won the distinction, which entitles her to a course of study in London extending over three years. Although an accomplished player of the piano, Miss Fisher has obtained her scholarship in violin work, in which she has specialized. She is a pupil of Miss Nora Kyffin Thomas, to whom she owes much for her rapid advancement. Her brilliant work at the Adelaide Conservatorium has

caused experts to predict a big future for her. She has been declared by many to be the most promising student to be sent abroad since Miss Daisy Kennedy.

—In Concerts at Four.—  
Miss Fisher has had a remarkable career. She started to play the piano when she was only four years of age, and six months later she appeared in her first concert, which was given at Unley Park by the pupils of Madame Jaunay. At five years old she passed the Primary Examination of the Associated Board of Music. She was then under the tuition of Miss Henriette Garnant. At five and a half years she started to learn the violin under Miss Kathleen Meegan. When she was six she passed the Elementary Examination of the Associated Board of Music with honours. She continued her studies for two years, and then it was feared that as the result of a dislocated elbow she would have to cease playing. In a couple of years' time, however, the arm was all right again, and she resumed study under Miss Nora Kyffin Thomas, with whom she has been ever since. Helena appeared in her first Conservatorium concert when only 10 years of age. Three years later she won the Elder Scholarship for the Adelaide Conservatorium, and passed the first year of her A.M.U.A. course, which she subsequently completed in all practical subjects on the violin. She would have finished in theory within the next few months, but, in view of her projected visit to London, she has decided to abandon this degree in order to secure the A.R.C.M. of the Royal College of Music.

—Continental Studies to follow.—  
Miss Fisher is the owner of a Stradivarius violin. There are only two such instruments in South Australia, the other one being possessed by Mr. Gerald Walker, of the Adelaide Conservatorium. It was purchased by her father about 12 months ago. In London Miss Fisher will probably study under the great master, Achille Bivarde. As she will be but 19 years of age when she completes the scholarship course, it is intended that she shall afterwards proceed to Germany and Italy to complete her musical education under the best masters in those countries. Although a lot of her time has been given to the study of the violin, the education of this remarkably talented musical student has not been neglected in other directions. She has maintained her pianoforte work, under the direction of Miss Puddy, at the Conservatorium, and she has reached senior public standard at the Adelaide University examinations. Miss Fisher expects to leave for England about April next. Her career will be watched with more than ordinary interest by Australians generally, and by South Australians in particular.
