Dear Chester,

I am sending the manuscript of the original measurements made in the tuberculin experiment. I suppose that a statistical amanuensis should copy and rearrange in a more compact form either the whole material, or, for example, all readings at 72 hours. If rearranged it would not, I think, be at all overwhelmingly voluminous. After all, there are only 120 cows with eight readings on each. Anyhow, the original manuscript, of which I have no copy, shows you the kind of stuff it is. I presume that all the qualitative indications, very diffuse, soft diffuse, which clutter up the pages, can be eliminated.
