Dear O'Brien,

I promised to send a note of the mouse-genes which I should most like to have in the near future. I shall only mention five, though of course I should like to have any novelty which may already be available for distribution by the time my commitment is made up. The ones I should like to get are two in the albino series, "Intense Chinchilla" and "Extreme Dilution", and three others known as "Leadon", "Fallow" (or Roberts' Pink eyed), and "Navy<sub>2</sub>", i.e. the second of the two Navy genes so far discovered.

It would be immensely helpful to me in starting a mouse-programme at Cambridge to have this assortment of genes already identified by capable geneticists such as Lunn.
