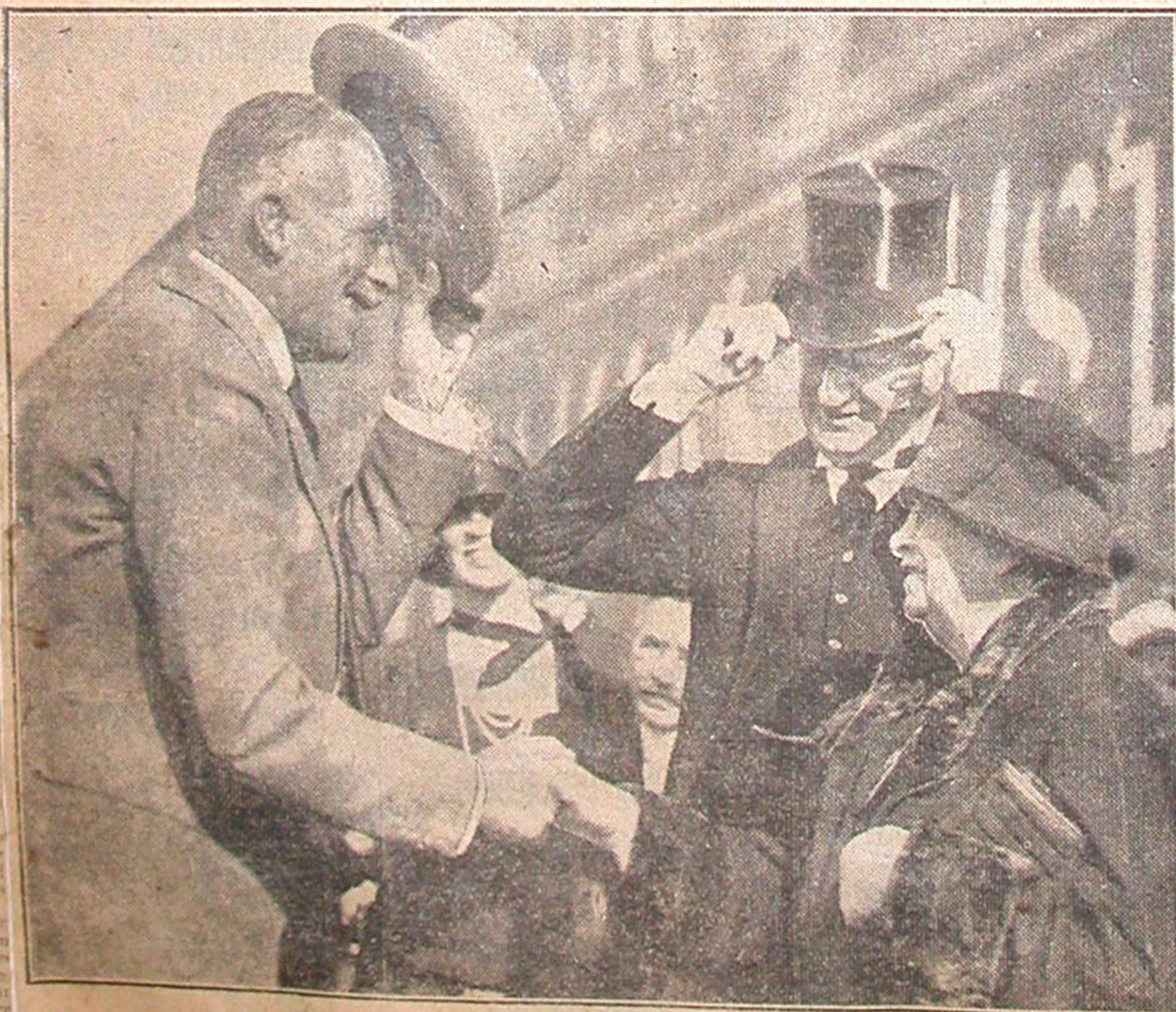


The retiring-Governor (Sir Tom Bridges) chatting to the Deputy-Governor (Sir George Murray) and Miss Murray.
